Cecil C. Cutting



Cecil C. Cutting, MD, was the first physician hired by Dr. Sidney R Garfield when Dr. Garfield joined forces with Henry J. Kaiser to provide prevention-oriented, prepaid medical care at the Grand Coulee Dam work site and later, in Kaiser's wartime shipyards. In 1948, Drs. Cutting and Garfield were in the handful of physicians who founded The Permanente Medical Group; Dr. Cutting was its first and longest serving executive director.
