

Safety is everyone's business. Take a safety walk with members of your team and check your workspace for possible dangers, such as awkward lifts, exposed cords or improper equipment. You can use a checklist from LMPartnership.org (link below) or simply address any hazards you observe. Do it regularly, perhaps weekly, with a "Make it Safer Monday" or "Safety Walk Wednesday."

BE SAFER!

Be observant. What task causes you the most concern for your safety or others?

Ensure the lines of communication are open. Ask your co-workers about their safety concerns and solutions.

Solve small issues immediately.

Alert others if you see a problem that can't be solved right away.

Find the right person to eliminate hazards.

Engage the whole team. Discuss safety concerns and solutions at your UBT meetings.

Rotate the safety "walker." Fresh eyes mean fresh perspectives and ideas.
